IOW are currently collaborating with the Breastfeeding network in family hubs, to run alongside child health clinics and Midwifery services with IOW Trust



- 3. The number of appointments with breastfeeding specialists provided by the trust in the month of February 2020, split, if possible, into those which took place face-to-face and those which took place remotely (e.g. either over phone or by video call):**

Southampton and Portsmouth combined data: 115 appointments, which are split as 67 face to face and 48 remote.

IOW 0-19 service was not within Solent NHS Trust at that time, so unable to access this data.

- 4. The number of appointments with breastfeeding specialists provided by the trust in the month of February 2022, split, if possible, into those which took place face-to-face and those which took place remotely (e.g. either over phone or by video call):**

Southampton and Portsmouth combined data: 179 appointments, which are split as 62 face to face and 117 remote.

IOW 0-19 service are unable to pull this data from systems as new to Solent and undergoing transformation, including BFI Accreditation and implementation of specialist roles.
